CONFERENCE PROGRAMME

FFD4 conference will feature a comprehensive programme comprising the official programme, side events and activities as well as press conferences and other visual coverage opportunities.

Official programme

The official programme of FFD4 features high-level opening, plenary, and closing sessions. In addition, several multi-stakeholder roundtables will address some of today's most pressing topics, aligned with the FFD action areas.

Sevilla Platform for Action

Sevilla Platform for Action will mobilize coalitions of countries and other stakeholders to launch ambitious initiatives to address common goals.

Side and special events

Over 300 events in which participating countries, United Nations entities, intergovernmental organizations and other accredited stakeholders will discuss development financing, sharing knowledge and solutions.

International Business Forum

The International Business Forum will be held alongside FFD4. It will bring together Heads of State, Ministers, CEOs, and prominent global business leaders to drive solutions that unlock private finance and investments for sustainable development.

Civil Society Forum

On June 28th and 29th, civil society organizations will discuss about their role to achieve a sustainable development.

PRESS CENTER

A press center will be available at the venue for accredited journalists covering the Conference.

Due to the size of the venue and the need to pass through security checks, we advise media representatives to arrive at the venue **well in advance** to ensure access to the event they wish to cover, especially on June 30.

TRANSPORTATION

How to get to Seville

By plane

[Seville Airport](#) is located 10 kilometers east of the city center and offers a wide range of domestic and international flights.

From Seville Airport, the city center can be reached in approximately 15 minutes by taxi, or around 35 minutes by [public bus](#) (Line EA - Special Airport Service).

By train

Seville has excellent rail connections to most of Spain's major cities from the [Santa Justa Train Station](#). The station is well connected to the Conference venue by RENFE's Cercanías line C4. The journey to the Palacio de Congresos station (FIBES) takes less than 10 minutes.

By bus

The [Plaza de Armas Bus Station](#) is Seville's main terminal for medium- and long-distance routes. The Seville-San Bernardo Bus Station also offers medium- and long-distance routes.



How to get to FIBES

Shuttle bus

The organizers will provide a special shuttle service connecting Seville's historic center with FIBES during the Conference. The departure and arrival point will be at [Paseo Cristobal Colón, 14](#) (on the opposite side of the street).

Service hours:

- 29 June: Bus from downtown to FIBES at 8:00 a.m. with a return bus at a time to be confirmed.
- 30 June: Continuous bus service from 7:00 a.m. until a time to be confirmed.
- 1-3 July: Continuous bus service from 8:00 a.m. to 8:00 p.m.

To access these shuttles, participants must present their official badge or the UN registration approval letter for the Conference.

Urban bus

FIBES is also connected to the city center by **three urban bus lines** with stops near the venue: **27, LE (Este Expres), and B4**. TUSSAM, the municipal transport company, provides full details about these routes and ticket options [on its website](#). TUSSAM also offers a mobile app available through this [link](#).

Cercanías train

FIBES is accessible via Cercanías trains, from the **Palacio de Congresos** station on **line C4**, just a few meters from the venue entrance. This line connects the city downtown to FIBES in only 10 minutes, with departures every 30 minutes. Car

For security and traffic control reasons, parking near the venue is not permitted. Participants are strongly encouraged to use public transportation or the shuttle service provided by the organizers.

Currency and payment cards: Euro (€); major credit and debit cards are widely accepted.

Smoking: Prohibited in all indoor common areas.

Tap water: Tap water is potable. Water fountains will be available throughout the venue, and participants will receive a reusable bottle to reduce plastic usage.
