As you mentioned before, seven years is quite a long time for an official visit, a bilateral meeting between the Prime Minister of the UK and the Prime Minister of Spain.

So, thank you very much for your kind words. Thank you very much for the warm hospitality on behalf of the Spanish delegation.

And I would like also to commend the leadership of Prime Minister Starmer when it comes to having closed successfully this very important agreement between Spain, the UK and the European Commission regarding Gibraltar, and also how the British Government reset its relations with the European Union, which is also very important for Spain.

So, we are two Governments aligned on many issues, on many policies.

As Prime Minister Starmer has said, we are going to sign a very important bilateral agreement, which will strengthen our cooperation and collaboration on many topics, gender equality, sustainable development, green energy transition and so on and so forth.

And last but not least, I think that we are very much aligned on global debates. The debates such as climate change, Ukraine, or the terrible tragedy of the situation that we are facing in Gaza.

So happy to be here, Prime Minister. Thank you very much, my dear friend.

I am looking forward to strengthening this cooperation and this friendship.
